Placement	Urology
Department	The Urology Department provides both secondary and tertiary care to our catchment population. The Department is manned by six Consultants and one Associate Specialist. Three Specialty Registrars work in the Department and work closely in supervising Foundation and Core Trainees. Ward 15 at Castle Hill Hospital is a dedicated 30 bedded Urology ward with adjacent Day Care facilities.
