Placement	Stroke Rehabilitation
Department	<p>The department offers excellent training opportunities in acute general medicine. On average there are 20-40 emergency admissions each day, plus Ambulatory Unit presentations. Consultants undertake post take ward rounds each day. All the major specialties have consultant cover. The facilities include a stroke/rehab unit, SSU, CCU, HDU and ITU beds as well as CT, MRI, coronary angiography, pacemaker fitting and endoscopy / bronchoscopy services.</p> <p>We have a busy Medical Assessment Unit assessing all acute medical admissions to the hospital, which provides excellent opportunity to gain experience in acute medicine. There are specialist nurse teams for cardiology, respiratory medicine and cancer.</p>
The type of work to expect and learning opportunities	In addition to the Generic Skills Programme there is mandatory F1 teaching session each Wednesday. There is also weekly Departmental Teaching and teaching clinics and ward rounds. There is also a monthly rolling audit programme.

<p>Main duties of the placement</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Day to day management of patients under consultant care. • Clerking of patients admitted to the unit. • Regular attendance at ward rounds held by consultant and registrar. • Completion of death certification, when necessary. • Assistance with the Radiology Department with X-Ray procedures as required through a rota arrangement. • Attendance at cardiac arrests. • The cover of colleagues on annual leave and short-term sickness. • Any other duties commensurate with the grade which may be allocated from time to time.
<p>Typical working pattern in this placement</p>	<p>Calderdale F1's will be required to work a 1:10 rota. This will include weekend work. On call responsibilities include providing cover for either the Medical Assessment or the wards.</p> <p>Huddersfield F1's work a 1:13 rota which includes weekend work. On Call responsibilities include providing cover for either the Medical Assessment Unit or Wards.</p>
