One morning a week working in the TB Clinic at Leeds General Infirmary. 3 days exchange with the FY2 working at Leeds Teaching Hospitals Trust microbiology department. Opportunity to undertake a number of visits and placements e.g. Leeds Prison Health Service, community TB Teams, infection control teams

Working as a member of the duty team one day a week dealing with health protection enquiries and incidents phoned in by health professionals and the public. Project work resulting in a presentation to the team at the end of the placement. One morning a week working in the TB Clinic at Leeds General Infirmary.
